### 1. Who is responsible for handling your data?

### 4. How long will we keep your personal data for?

### 6. Who will you share my data with?

Your data will not be shared with third parties.

### 7. What are your rights?

Every individual has the right to be informed as to whether the URV is handling their personal data or not.

You have the right to access your personal data and to ask for it to be rectified or removed if, among other reasons, the data are no longer required for the purpose for which they were originally collected.

In certain circumstances established in article 18 of the GDPR, individuals may request the restriction of the processing of their data. In these cases, we will only retain your data for the purposes of exercising or defending any claims.

### 8. How can I exercise my rights?

### 9. How can I make a claim?

If you think that your rights have not been adequately safeguarded, you have the right to submit a claim to the Autoritat Catalana de Protecció de Dades (Catalan Data Protection Authority). You can also submit a claim to the individual responsible for data protection at the URV.
